

5 Ways to Engage in Community Land Use Decisions

1. Check the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability website to stay informed of current and upcoming long-term land use planning projects. You can also learn about Zoning Code amendments and updates: www.portlandonline.com/planning
 2. Attend Open Houses hosted the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to learn more about new planning projects.
 3. Make your voice heard. Testify at Planning Commission and City Council hearings when development projects or land use policies are proposed that affect your neighborhood. Schedules are available on the website.
 4. Comment on Land Use Review proposals in your neighborhood. Written comments that address the appropriate approval criteria and are sent during the comment period will be addressed in the planner's decision.
