

Neighborhood Banner Contest

The Creston-Kenilworth Neighborhood Association is seeking a design for banners that will be hung on utility-poles throughout the neighborhood.

We are looking for a design that:

- Showcases current and/or past visible landmarks in the neighborhood, such as the Community Music Center, the historic Street Car line that ran down Gladstone Street, or the Douglas fir trees in Creston and Kenilworth Parks.
- Includes the neighborhood name.
- Uses 4 or fewer colors (colored canvas material with up to 3 screen print colors).
- Can be easily enlarged to fit onto banners that are 30 inches (2 ½ feet) wide and 60 inches (5 feet) high (designs should be about twice as tall as they are wide).
